# THREE CORE VALUES PERHAPS A TRIUNE MODEL

Triune Model

The three Core Values form a triangle
Faith at the bottom, the foundational value
Service and Social Justice on either side
God inside the triangle

# TRIUNE MODEL

Guided by the National Theme
Catholic and Living it
Integrated into all three core values

## HOW

#### Charism

refers to a council's special gift or grace from the Holy Spirit for the common good, or for the service of others that help the council to live out its mission with the Church.

# EVALUATE COUNCIL'S WORK

- Prioritize from the most important to the least important activities
- Ask: What two or three things could we focus on that really would make a difference?

Remember – We can't be all things to all people

Council needs to be involved in this process

## ASSESS EACH PROJECT

- What part of the project falls under each core value?
- What part of the project will each committee chair take responsibility for?
- How does each member see themselves fitting in?

## DEVELOP A PROGRAM

Executive with the help of the membership develops a program reflecting the councils charism, priorities, and National Theme

Faith, Service and Social Justice are the three focal points

## PROGRAM REFLECTS OUR CHARISM

It must be the filter for all our work
